Limitations on CRU Staff Participation in Research

Purpose: To provide guidelines for CRU staff participation in research protocols.

Procedures:

- 1) CRU staff members are prohibited from participating in any CRU-supported research protocol regardless of where the research is conducted. Under unusual or extraordinary circumstances, a CRU staff member can file a petition to GAC for an exception to this policy.

- 2) A CRU staff member may be a research participant if he/she responds to recruitment notices for non-CRU studies. The CRU permits CRU staff members to participate as controls or volunteers in these studies on their own time, i.e. not during assigned work hours for the CRU.
