Sleep Study Monitoring and Intervention	

Purpose: To identify procedure for Sleep Study Monitoring and Intervention.

Policy: To assure the quality of sleep data if a sensor gets lost or if the waveform is of a poor quality.

1. The CRU staff must monitor the subject during the entire course of the study.
2. Complete and update: Research Nightly Checklist.
3. The CRU staff are required to intervene and replace lost sensors and/or poor quality sleep sensors on all research protocols in a timely manner; unless a request is made in subject's orders by the principal investigator, and clearly states the following:
 - i. Not to intervene.
 - OR
 - ii. Only intervene, if a specific sensor(s) has been lost and/or of poor quality..
4. Document findings on the Work Pad (Tags) and the Research Nightly Checklist (All applicable fields). See attachment for revised Research Nightly Checklist.
