Standing Physician Orders

Purpose: To delineate the approval process of Physician Standing Orders for Research Studies.

Procedure:

1. GCRC Standing Physician Orders include general pharmaceutical agents and care modalities that enhance research subject care and do not interfere with research design.
2. Prior to initiation of a GCRC study, the Principal Investigator will review the list of approved GCRC Standing Orders. The Principal Investigator or physician designee shall individualize the list based on the appropriateness for his/her subjects and research study.
3. A master physician's standing order sheet for each study will then be generated. The sheet will include the Name of the Study and its RPN number. The master order sheet will remain on file in the GCRC Protocol book for that study.
4. A copy of the master physician's order sheet will be signed by the PI or physician designee for each subject in the study and be included in the Medical Record.
5. Standing orders will be reviewed for pertinence on at least a yearly basis and revised as needed.
